The government prescribes the following

Scope

Section 1. This Regulation lays down provisions that supplement the Council Regulation (EC) No 4/2009 of 18 December 2008 on jurisdiction, applicable law, recognition and enforcement of decisions and cooperation in matters relating to maintenance obligations (the Maintenance Regulations).

The Central Authority

Section 2. According to the Maintenance Regulations, the Swedish Social Insurance Agency is the central authority that is subject to the duties required from central authorities according to the Regulations.

Documents

Section 3. The Central Authority shall provide forms of applications and requests to the authority for assistance in individual matters relating to maintenance obligations.

Section 4. A certified translator may do translations in accordance with Articles 20.3, 28.3, 29.2 and 40.4.

Section 5. If someone so requests, a court or other authority shall certify the authenticity of a copy of the decision announced by this authority.

An extract according to Article 40 shall be issued by the court or other authority that had announced the decision.

Section 6. If someone so requests, a social welfare board shall certify the authenticity of a copy of the maintenance allowance contract approved by the social welfare board.

An extract according to Article 48 shall be issued by the social welfare board that had approved the contract on maintenance obligations.

Section 7. / Enters into force on 01.05.2012 /

If someone so requests, the Swedish Enforcement Administration shall certify a contract on maintenance allowance.

An extract in accordance with Article 48 shall be issued by the Swedish Enforcement Authority. Regulation (2012:149).
